### Evaluation

A technician will conduct a thorough head check. If the presence of nits (eggs) is confirmed, we then move on to step 2.



### LouseBuster

A disposable applicator tip attached to the LouseBuster is used to direct only carefully controlled heated air against the roots and scalp, killing the lice and their nits where they live. This step takes approximately 30 minutes and uses no chemicals.



### Comb Out

The technician will now use a specially designed comb to perform a thorough comb-out.



This comb out removes the dead lice and nits from the hair and scalp. Depending on the hair type this process will take approximately 30-40 minutes.
